"You were slaves to those who by nature are not gods"—Galatians 4:8 NIV.

Macro-Evolution, or Darwinism has achieved godlike status in the scientific and educational communities. It has achieved such honor as a sacred-cow, that it is not supposed to be even questioned.

Darwinian evolution depends primarily on one thing: speciation, which is defined as "the formation of new and distinct species in the course of evolution". Evolutionists claim they have lots of "proof" for this. However, when their claims are examined, (excluding the outright frauds, such as "Piltdown Man"), they are simply assertions, or assumptions without actual proof. The big assumption the theory hangs on is the minor variations within "kinds", that is called Micro-Evolution. A typical example is the many different varieties of dogs, but they are all still dogs, no matter how much variation there is between them. The problem for evolutionists is that we don't see dogs evolving into deer or bears do we? So Darwinists are forced claim that over long periods of time, such as millions of years, these large-scale changes occurred. The reason we don't see them happening now is that over a relatively short period of time, say a hundred years even, these changes can't be seen.

The real reason, however, is because Macro-Evolution is fiction, it does not happen now, and has never happened. Science that is proven bears out the truthfulness of the Bible:

"Then God said, 'Let the land produce vegetation: seed-bearing plants and trees on the land that bear fruit with seed in it, according to their various kinds.' And it was so. The land produced vegetation: plants bearing seed according to their kinds and trees bearing fruit with seed in it according to their kinds. And God saw that it was good. And there was evening, and there was morning—the third day.... So God created the great creatures of the sea and every living thing with which the water teems and that moves about in it, according to their kinds, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that it was good.... And God said, 'Let the land produce living creatures according to their kinds: the livestock, the creatures that move along the ground, and the wild animals, each according to its kind.' And it was so. God made the wild animals according to their kinds, the livestock according to their kinds, and all the creatures that move along the ground according to their kinds. And God saw that it was good." (Genesis 1:11-12, 21, 24-25 NIV)

If Macro-Evolution were true, it should be quite easy to demonstrate it with bacteria. Why don't they?

University of Bristol (England) bacteriologist Alan H. Linton concluded: "None exists in the literature claiming that one species has been shown to evolve into another. Bacteria, the simplest form of independent life, are ideal for this kind of study, with generation times of twenty to thirty minutes, and populations achieved after eighteen hours. But throughout 150 years of the science of bacteriology, there is no evidence that one species of bacteria has changed into another... Since there is no evidence for species changes between the simplest forms of unicellular life, it is not surprising that there is no evidence for evolution from prokaryotic [e.g., bacteria] to eukaryotic [e.g., plant and animal] cells, let alone throughout the whole array of higher multicellular organisms."

"According to their kinds"—Genesis 1:11,12,21,24,25 NIV. As is true for plant and

animal life, the same is true for bacteria, they reproduce only "according to their kinds". After trillions and trillions of generations of bacteria, they are still bacteria-no evolving up an "evolutionary chain".

"Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world"—1 Cor 1:20 NIV.
