BBC News published an article on April 27, 2017, entitled: "Why Fish Do Not Deserve Their Reputation for Forgetfulness." As with so many other new discoveries, this one has forced evolutionists to revise their theories about fish. Let's examine some quotes about fish from this article:

"This widely-held belief may persist due to ... an old-fashioned view of how evolution works."

Wait a minute!—Something seems very awfully "fishy" here! Fish are supposedly lower on the evolutionary ladder. so, how do they have so much complexity, etc.? In some ways, they are superior to creatures higher on the evolutionary ladder, such as humans. How can this be?

Because Darwinian, or macro-evolution, is false - blatantly untrue!

"And God said, 'Let the waters swarm with swarms of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the expanse of the heavens.'
