**“When he hands over the kingdom to his God and Father”—1 Corinthians 15:24

When the Bible refers to “his God,” who is it referring to?

“from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood, and has made us to be a kingdom and priests to serve his God and Father—to him be glory and power for ever and ever! Amen”—Revelation 1:5,6 NIV

“His God” refers to Jesus' Father.

“Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ”—2 Corinthians 1:3,4 NIV

“With one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ”—Romans 15:6 NAB

“The God and Father of the Lord Jesus knows, he who is blessed forever”—2 Corinthians 11:31 NAB

“Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ”—Ephesians 1:3 NAB

“The God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the God of glory”—Ephesians 1:17 NAB

Who, Or What, is the God of Jesus?

“I know that you do not have the love of God in you. I came in the name of my Father . . . How can you believe, when you . . . do not seek the praise that comes from the only God?”—John 5:42-44 NAB

“God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ”—Colossians 1:3 NAB

The God of Jesus is his Father. The scriptures overwhelmingly support this fact. Anyone with God over them cannot be God himself, so the main pillar of the Trinity doctrine, namely, that the Father, the Son, and the holy Spirit are each equally God, and yet only one God, is proven false on this point alone from the scriptures.
